CHILD FIND PROGRAM

The district has an obligation to offer a free and appropriate public education to students with disabilities who are residents of the district. With parental consent, district staff evaluates students who may require specialized instruction and/or other accommodations to access and benefit from the educational services and programs our schools offer. If you believe your child has a disability that requires specialized instruction or accommodations, you are encouraged to contact your child's building principal or the Office of Special Education at 518-793-7395 to discuss whether a referral to the Committee on Special Education or the 504 Team is appropriate.

BOARD OF EDUCATION

The Board of Education of the Glens Falls City School District is made up of nine members who are elected by the qualified voters of the district. They serve without pay for five-year terms. The Board of Education, in serving its role as trustee of the district's five schools,

is responsible for the development of policy through which the Superintendent administers the educational program. All community residents are encouraged to attend public meetings of the Board, typically held at 7 p.m. in the Administration Building, located at 15 Quade Street. Meeting dates are listed in this calendar. Special meetings called during the course of the year are posted on www.gfsd.org.

The district's annual budget vote and elections to the Board of Education are typically held in May. For more information, call the District Clerk at 518-792-1212.

PESTICIDE APPLICATIONS

The Glens Falls City School District is required by law to maintain a list of faculty, staff and persons in parental relation who wish to receive 48-hour prior written notification of pesticide applications at relevant facilities. If you would like to be on the notification list, please fill out a notification form, available at the main office of each school building.
